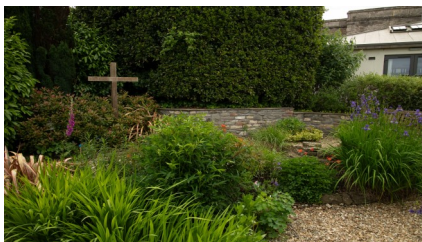
> **Church Flowers** - The flowers today are given by Irene Fowler in memory of her late Husband's Birthday.
